Fulfilling this duty safeguards the interests of our Rotary Club and Rotarians by minimizing our risk of liability, including legal liability, should any participant in a Rotary activity become a victim of abuse.

Statement of Conduct for working with Youth

Rotary Club of San Jose is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for all participants in Rotary activities. It is the duty of all Rotarians, Rotarian spouses, partners, and any other volunteers to safeguard to the best of their ability the welfare of and to prevent the physical, sexual, or emotional abuse of children and young people with whom they come in contact. All Rotarians and other adult volunteers who have one-on-one or otherwise unsupervised contact/involvement with youth in Rotary context will require full Rotary District 5170 Youth Protection Training Certification.

By signing this Agreement, I certify that I will have no unsupervised contact/involvement with any youth in a rotary context. I also hereby certify that I have never been convicted of, or otherwise found to have engaged in sexual abuse or harassment involving youth.
